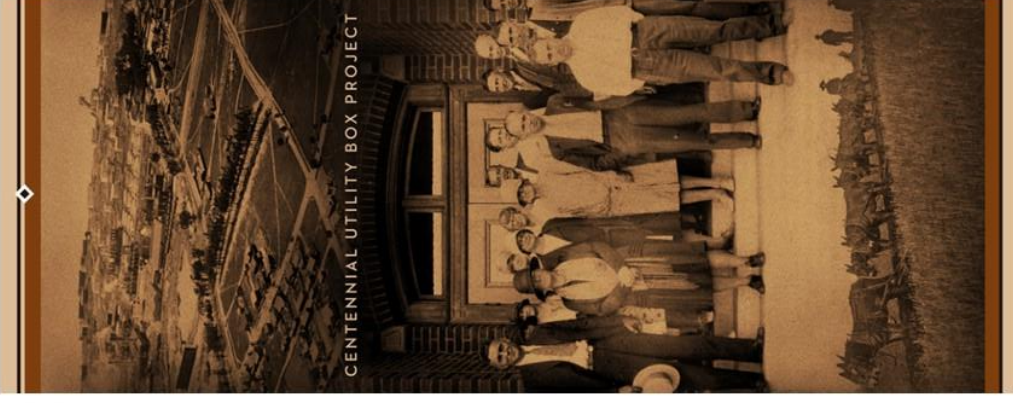

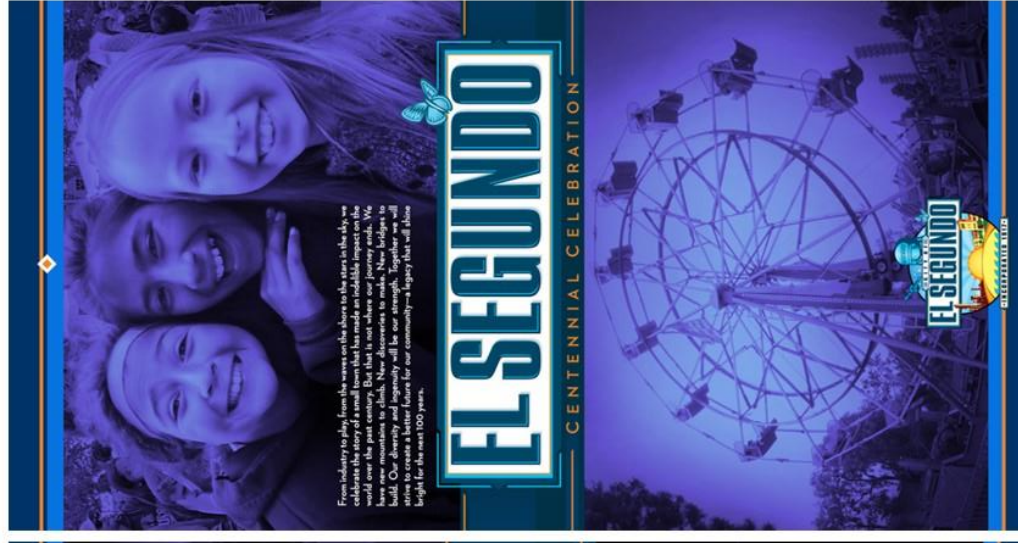
Box location: South end of Main Street, east side near I <3 Teriyaki
